Arrive with peace of mind.

Your arrival

- Example: check-in between 4 pm and 7 pm, check-out before 11 am.
- Before travelling, confirm the address, directions, parking and your arrival time with your host.
- Key collection is arranged privately. No real access codes are published in this guide.

Connect and settle in

- Your host would provide the Wi-Fi network name and password on arrival.
- Ask your host to show you the heating controls, sockets and equipment in your room.
- For any difficulty, use the contact in your stay confirmation. This demo provides no real support contact.

Before closing your suitcase

- Save the address and your host's contact details offline.
- Confirm your arrival time; let your host know if you are delayed.
- Check directions, parking and key collection arrangements.
- Discuss mobility, accessibility or children's equipment needs before travelling.
- Pack walking shoes, sun protection, a water bottle and rainwear.

Details to confirm with your host

Linen & cleaning	Linen provision, changes and cleaning during your stay.
Kitchen & meals	Kitchen access, breakfast and any dietary requirements.
Bikes & beach	Bicycle storage, drying belongings and any available equipment.
Children & pets	Equipment, admission conditions and property rules.

The lounge

Read a few pages, talk quietly and let the day settle.
A shared space for moments without an agenda.



Kitchen & table

A large table and natural materials set the scene for
a shared meal. Agree kitchen access with your host.

Spaces to share

- The lounge is a place to read or spend time together; the terrace extends the house outdoors on fine days.
- Example: breakfast from 8 am to 10 am. Agree kitchen access with your host.
- Leave shared spaces tidy after use and ask where to store bicycles and beach belongings.



The terrace

Morning coffee or a pause after a walk. Leave seating tidy and
respect the peace of other guests.

A thoughtful way to stay.



Looking after the house

- Example: keep noise down between 10 pm and 8 am, indoors and on the terrace.
- Air rooms briefly, turn off unused lights and close windows while the heating is on.
- Follow the recycling instructions on site. Confirm smoking and pet policies before your stay.

Time outdoors

- Find ideas for reading, walks and shared moments in the inspiration notebook on the website.
- Before going out, check local sources for weather, access conditions and notices on site.
- The local guide lists real activities and their sources. The inspiration notebook offers flexible suggestions without booking.

Before heading to the beach

- Check today's conditions and lifeguard hours with the town of Lacanau.
- Use the supervised area and follow flags and lifeguard instructions.
- A red flag means swimming is prohibited. No flag means the beach is not supervised.
- Baïnes can produce strong rip currents: ask lifeguards for advice before entering the water.

If the weather changes

Choose a lounge break, a shared meal or the website's inspiration notebook in "Indoors" mode. These flexible ideas do not replace current weather information.

Pack water, suitable shoes, sun protection and binoculars if you enjoy birdwatching.

Free entry. Allow 7.5 km return from the car park; leave bicycles at the entrances. Bring water and walking shoes.

Explore Lac de Lacanau by paddleboard or kayak from Le Moutchic. Cris Loisirs offers several hire options.

Good to know

Paid, seasonal activity. Confirm conditions and suitable equipment for your group with the hire provider.

Before booking, explain your ability, participants' ages and check what equipment is included. Keep an alternative if conditions change.

Discover surfing in Lacanau-Océan with a local school and a lesson suited to your ability.

Good to know

Paid lessons vary by school. Agree a time with the instructor: sea conditions determine the session.

04 Cycling · Get moving Cycle among the pines

Explore a stretch of La Vélodyssée around Lacanau towards Carcans, between coast and forest.

Good to know

Choose a distance that suits your fitness. The dunes towards Carcans are hilly; check the route before setting out.

Leave with nothing forgotten.

Before heading home

- Example: leave your room before 11 am, or agree another time with your host.
- Check drawers, sockets and the bathroom, then close windows and turn off lights.
- Return keys as agreed and report any forgotten belongings or damaged equipment.

One last look around

- ☐ Phone, chargers, documents and valuables collected.
- ☐ Drawers, bathroom and sockets checked.
- ☐ Windows closed and lights switched off.
- ☐ Shared spaces tidied and waste sorted as instructed.
- ☐ Keys returned as agreed; problems or forgotten items reported.
